## THE QUEEN'S GLOVES — REGALIA WORN BY ALL QUEENS OF THE OUTLANDS

DURING THE REIGN OF KING MAELGWN II AND QUEEN CAINNLEACH,

Chatelaines: If the gloves should become damaged, please contact Lyssa at <a href="leofsige@gmail.com">leofsige@gmail.com</a> so arrangements may be made for repair. This pair of gloves is part of the Queen's Regalia and should be worn as much as possible. They may be worn on the belt, as gloves, or even over the White Scarf that is worn on the bicep.

These gloves are to be presented to the Queen during Coronation any time the White Scarf is presented. They should not live in a box. Queens have had to fight to secure them from the stores. Please don't make our Queens work so hard to be the Patroness of the Archers who love them.

At the request of Her Majesty Ingriðr, this information must be kept in the Chatelaine's records along with the gloves so future folks will know that this is a pair and that the Queen should be wearing them as regularly as the White Scarf regalia.



In order to show the dedication of the archery community and gratitude to the Queens of the Outlands for their patronage of the community and the orders of the Sharparrow and the Golden Pheon, a pair of white gloves were created.

The gloves are of white pig suede, lined with gold silk, and embellished on one hand by the badge of the Grant Level Sharparrow complimented on the other with the badge of the AoA level Golden Pheon. The badges are hand beaded. The gloves are hand stitched with white silk and embellished with gold and white tassels. Additionally, they incorporate a button and loop on opposite sides of each glove so they may be buttoned palms together. This places the tassels on opposite sides to reduce bulk. The buttons and loops allow the Queens to wear them over a belt while displaying one of the two badges or over the white scarf when it is worn on the bicep rather than over the shoulder.



As part of the Queen's Regalia, the gloves are and should be worn by every Queen of the Outlands.

Note from the artist: My apologies for the never ending confusion of using both emblems on the gloves, but at the time it seemed the best way to represent the entire community. 20 hours into the beading of emblems, it seemed better to continue and spend the rest of time explaining the double emblems. They reflect the entirety of the recognized archers of the Outlands but the Sharparrow is the Grant order to which we look for leadership. Lyssa
